

Which institutions/organizations ?

- Cultural institutions in the broad sense: Performing Arts Centres, Broadcasters, Libraries, Film, games and multimedia producers, Design and Architecture institutions, Museums, Heritage and Parks, Sports, Cultural associations, Indigenous Tradition & Knowledge and so on.
- Larger institutions or federations/networks representing smaller ones. Smaller institutions with special interest and experiences to share.
- City/municipality or other authorities working with eco-social change
- Civic or business stakeholders working with eco-social change
- Research institutions or networks working with eco-social change

A special – but not exclusive – priority is given to members in large cities and/or their region to address the fact that a major challenge in the 2050 transition is the 75% of world population in cities. City/regional Culture|Futures networks are encouraged, but no formal set ups will be recognized unless based on multi-stakeholder approach recognized as such by city.

Institutional Membership Offers:

- Be part of a building a new global, interdisciplinary network of cultural institutions exploring and sharing new eco-social practices
- Network with colleagues and with large cities and other large stakeholders in eco-social agenda's in a broad sense, i.e. ecology, human rights, social responsibility, equal opportunities.
- Participate in or co-host Culture|Futures city conferences in own city or with other cities in region/other regions as appropriate
- Participate in or co-host annual global conference for network from 2012 (expected)
- Access and exchange information on emerging practices with Culture|Futures network members directly and via Culture|Futures communication platform (will be made available in steps over the coming year).
- Opportunity to lead regionally/internationally in specific areas/projects relevant to the institution and to the Culture|Futures – network

Institutional Requirements:

- Appoint contact person(s) from institution
- Be listed as member with logo
- Willing to explore collaborations of relevance to institution, e.g. research, new institutional practices, collaborations or productions and so on
- Cover own costs for participating
- Support directly, in-kind or in other ways the Culture|Futures network , to enable activities and inclusion of institutions in need of support.
- Be aware the network is international by nature, and that local city or regional activities rely on initiatives of the city ('s) and institutions in the region.

Network development

The network will develop over the coming 3-4 years through Culture|Futures conferences and workshops in cities and regions around the world along with the global communication platform and different levels of global events, advocacy, research driven and communicated by partners.
